The Standards of Performance described for these events should provide fun and friendly competition for our members, as well as our fine bird dogs. Trophies will be awarded to the Best Juvenile, Best Adult, Best Veteran, and Best Gun Dog. All Adult, Veteran, and Gun Dogs are in contention to win the Dog and Handler Combination Trophy. We will also offer a Modified Stake to accommodate dogs and/or handlers needing easier terrain.

The Schedule

7:00 AM - Field Trial Begins Noon – Happy Hour (gather, snack, refresh) 1:00 PM – General Meeting; Nominations for President, Vice, Treasurer and Secretary Potluck Lunch - bring your favorite dish or dessert; Presentation of Ribbons.

Entry and Brace Info

Entries are by advanced registration only. Send entries to **Meghan Carr 194 Tobey Hwy Greenville NH 03048 Cell- (603-562-6244) – or –Email- <u>mmclatchy89@gmail.com</u> You can text, or email your entry with <u>complete entry info and then bring your physical</u> <u>form to the event</u> Please fill out the entry form with registered name of dog for possible engraving purposes**.

<u>Checks are payable to</u>: Central New England Brittany Club (\$15/first dog entry, \$5 each for additional dog entered) Text and email entries may pay the day of event. Please include entry form.

Once entries close, the running order will be posted on the CNEBC Facebook page and also e-mailed to the club members on **Friday**, **December 6th**.

<u>A dog may enter only one event.</u> Trophy Stakes are Juvenile, Adult, Veteran or Steady Stake. Criteria below. Braces will be 20-30 minutes depending on the number of entries. There is a Modified Stake available to accommodate dogs and/or handlers needing easier terrain. All placements will receive ribbons.

First brace will be at 7:00 A.M.

Members are responsible for the entry fee even if they must cancel, because the birds will have already been ordered.

Central New England Brittany Club Standards of Performance

JUVENILE STAKE: At least 5 months of age but not older than 24 months. The juvenile must show desire to hunt, be attractive, show style of running, and demonstrate not only intelligence in seeking objectives but also the ability to find game. Juveniles should establish point and must show reasonable obedience to the commands of the handler. Each dog is to be judged on actual performance as indicating its future promise as a gun dog. The juvenile may be fired over using a blank pistol.

ADULT STAKE: No age limit for Adult. The adult dog must give a stylish performance and be under the handler's control at all times. The adult dog must show strong desire to hunt, have an attractive style in the field, and must demonstrate not only intelligence in quartering and seeking objectives, but also the ability to find game. The dog must hunt for the handler at all times within a suitable range for the hunter and must handle kindly (with a minimum of noise from the handler). The dog must cover ground adequately but never range out of sight for a length of time that would detract from its usefulness as a practical hunting dog. The dog must locate game and must point staunchly. No additional credits shall be given for steadiness to wing and shot. Intelligent use of the wind and terrain in locating game, accurate nose, style, and intensity are essential. A blank pistol must be used.

VETERAN STAKE: 9 years old and up. The veteran dog must give a stylish performance and be under the handler's control at all times. The veteran dog must show strong desire to hunt, have an attractive style in the field, and must demonstrate not only intelligence in quartering and seeking objectives, but also the ability to find game. The dog must hunt for the handler at all times within a suitable range for the hunter and must handle kindly (with a minimum of noise from the handler). The dog must cover ground adequately but never range out of sight for a length of time that would detract from its usefulness as a practical hunting dog. The dog must locate game and must point staunchly. No additional credits shall be given for steadiness to wing and shot. Intelligent use of the wind and terrain in locating game, accurate nose, style, and intensity are essential. A blank pistol must be used.

STEADY STAKE: No age limit. The Gun Dog must give a finished performance and be under control of the handler at all times. It must handle kindly and with minimum of noise and hacking from the handler. It must show a keen desire to hunt, have a bold and attractive style of running, and must demonstrate not only intelligence in quartering and seeking objectives, but also the ability to find game. The dog must hunt for its handler at all times within a range suitable for the hunter and should show or check in front of the hunter frequently. It must cover adequate ground but not range out of sight for a length of time that would detract from its usefulness as a practical hunting dog. The dog must locate game, point staunchly, and be steady to wing and shot. Intelligent use of the wind and terrain in locating game, accurate nose, style, and intensity on point are essential. A blank pistol must be used.

MODIFIED STAKE: No age limit. Same criteria as **Adult/Veteran**. Designed to accommodate dogs and/or handlers needing easier terrain
